

GAME RULES

Instructions:

[1] Banker – There will be a dedicated dealer at each table. The Banker has last say on ALL matters. The responsibilities of the banker include the following:

- Handle all money, help move along play and encourage trading.
- Pass out \$1,500 to each player (already divided in bags).
- **Before the game starts, randomly deal one (1) property card to each player. Players pay the value of the property card (listed on the game board) BEFORE the game starts.**
- Give \$200 to each player as they pass GO.
- Give winners with the highest net worth a ticket to proceed to the next round.
 - **VIP TABLES:** After Round 1, THREE (3) PLAYERS advance to Round 2. Only ONE (1) PLAYER advances to Round 3.
 - **GENERAL ADMISSION TABLES:** After Rounds 1 & 2, ONE PLAYER proceeds to the next round.
- Winners DO NOT carry any of their money or properties to the next round.

[2] Rules

- The player to the left of the banker rolls first.
- Players receive \$200 for landing on FREE PARKING.
- Players will not receive \$100 for rolling Snake Eyes (two ones).
- Players are responsible for collecting rent on their own properties.

[3] Properties and Mortgages

- EISENOPOLY = owning all of the properties in a particular color group (e.g., both blue properties). This is required before you can purchase homes.
- 3 or 4 homes (depending on the property) MUST be purchased on a property prior to the purchase of a hotel.
- Rent cannot be collected on a mortgaged property.
- Any mortgaged property should be placed down on the table and is NOT counted in your final total earnings.

[4] Deals, Trades and Buying Houses/Hotels

- Deals, trades, and buying houses/hotels can ONLY occur on YOUR TURN PRIOR to rolling.
- **You have 30 SECONDS to complete any deals/trades/purchases (there are 30-second timers on each table).**
- **NO friendly bets, NO collusion, and NO rigging.**

[5] Rolling Doubles

- If you roll doubles, you get to roll again.
- Rolling doubles 3 TIMES in a row = GO TO JAIL.

[6] Jail

- To get out of Jail, you must use a "Get Out of Jail Free" card or pay \$50. You may roll again immediately afterwards; you do not lose your turn.
- No rolling doubles to get out of Jail.
- Convicts may collect rent on their properties while in Jail.

[7] End of Game

- When time is called at the end of the round, ALL PLAY STOPS. Players tally up earnings by:
 - a. Cash.
 - b. Properties, Utilities and Railroads (Value is printed on board; mortgaged properties do not count in the final total).
 - c. Houses valued at purchase price.
 - d. Hotels valued at purchase price, including value of turned in houses.
