Une Femme "the Juliette" 1er Cru by Gonet-Medeville

Champagne, France

This 1er Cru Champagne comes from the Gonet-Medville estate, and its pedigree stands tall amongst the other big Champagne houses. The Juliette is a very clean, bright and energetic style of bubbles, with delicate toasty brioche notes that don't weigh down the wine. The bubbles are smaller, yet very persistent. Elegance in a glass. Uplifting, not heavy.

2019 Kelley Fox Rosé of Pinot Gris

Willamette Valley, Oregon

Wow. Incredibly rich, concentrated and bright rose full of wild strawberry, cranberry and other red fruits. Less than 150 cases are made of this beauty....and usually this wine is so rare that it never leaves Oregon. Here's your chance to drink a rose like no other. Mind blowing experience here.

2017 Quintodecimo Greco di Tufo, "Giallo d'Arles"

Italy

Greco is a dry white grape that can have apricot/peach/exotic notes with traces of stony minerality. Let me just say, this is BY FAR the best example of an "alternative white wine" from Italy, I've had in years. Sip away, be patient, and get lost in the numerous complexities that are about to dazzle your senses. Serious wine drinkers: this is a must try. I was thinking about this Greco di Tufo for DAYS after first trying it.

2017 Jacques Rouzé Sauvignon Blanc

Quincy, France

Crisp citrus - check! Stony minerality - check! Refreshing mouthfeel - check! This Sauvignon Blanc has it all! Quincy is a French region right next to Sancerre and they drink similarly. Whereas most Sauvignon Blanc is very straight-forward, notice how this example delivers not only on the palate, but the longgg finish and the wonderful, almost juicy texture.

2017 Chanin Chardonnay

Bien Nacido, California

This gorgeous bottle is limited, hard to procure and full of flavor. Gavin Chanin is a very young newcomer to the world of winemaking, and in just two years of making wine, has been credited with 95+ points for every wine he has made. This Chardonnay has the perfect balance of oak, toast, vanilla, apple fruits acacia flowers and soft baking spices....it truly is the gift that keeps on giving.

2018 Arendsig Pinotage

South Africa

This wine is one of my all time favorites ever. If you've never had a Pinotage, now is the time. The aromatics bring me right back to the porch in South Africa drinking with the winemaker. Rich, concentrated, smooth, light on the tannins and balanced. It is everything you want in a juicy red wine without any of the drawbacks.

2017 Venge Silencieux Cabernet

Napa Valley, California

Nils & Kirk Venge are a father/son winemaking duo that are some of Napa's finest at what they do... and most don't know their name. Both have been responsible for making 100 point wines in their past, and this INCREDIBLE Cabernet is nothing less than elite, posting ratings no lower than 94 points for 4 vintages. Everything you'd expect out of a Napa Cab and then some.

2017 Favia Carbone Red Blend

Napa Valley, California

This wine is a passion project from the same winemaker who makes Screaming Eagle (yes the most elite CA red wine that's thousands of dollars a bottle). This Cabernet dominant blend is age worthy, but so drinkable now. How can an elite, rare, premium red blend be SO approachable, yet so complex? Give this wine time to open up.

Jo Landron "Atmospheres" Sparkling Folle Blanche

Loire Valley, France

Holy cow there's a lot going on in this bubbly bottle! I was taken back by it's razor-sharp focus, pristine energy, freshness, layered complexity and overall level of joy. Every sip made me crave another. Dry bubbles here, but with LOADS of fresh fruit and flippin' memorable!

2018 Brotte Rosé "Les Eglantiers"

Tavel. France

Elegance & intensity in the same glass? Yes please! Deep in color and sultry on the palate, this hefty-style rose is dry, age-worthy, and comes from the most elite pink wine region in the world. If you like red wine, chill this down and give it a try.

2019 Kobal Pinot Grigio

Slovenia

When was the last time you enjoyed a Pinot Grigio from Podravje, in the region of Štajerska Slovenia? Never? Well now's your chance! Notice the slightly pink hue on this beautifully crafted wine. If the aromatics alone don't knock you out of your seat, the texture and round, full flavors surely will.

2018 Georg Gustav Huff Dry Riesling

Rheinhessen, Germany

Ok seriously, this is THE Riesling to try, if you think you don't like Riesling. It's not a sweet dessert treat, peeps. Crisp, full of minerality, lush quince and pear fruits and all sorts of mouth-tingling freshness are just some of the amazing reactions you should expect from this German treat. Small producer here, working meticulously on a wine that overdelivers on all counts. Dry. (c'mon Sauv Blanc/Pinot Grigio drinkers..... let's do thisssss!)

2018 Lioco Chardonnay

Sonoma, California

This is not your typical Chardonnay. Ditch the creamy, oaky, vanilla weight and be consumed with tropical pineapple fruits, loads of mouthwatering acidity and a gorgeous toasted kiss. One of the most balanced Chardonnays I've had from California, and the younger, hip winemakers involved with this project have something REALLY special going on here.

RED

2018 Guillot Broux Coteaux Bourgignons (Pinot Noir/Gamay)

Burgundy, France

When I asked this winemaker why his wine is SO GOOD for the price, his response was "yeah I pretty much have the best deal in the wine world, with this Pinot Noir/Gamay blend." He's not wrong. Friends, if you like good Pinot Noir, or have had your head turn from a good red Burgundy, then this wine is for you. I'd pay twice as much for this wine. Soft, earthy, fuzzy forest floor notes embrace the tart raspberry and purple fruits on this wine, showing TONS of depth and sexiness.

2017 Gulfi Rossojbleo (Nero D'Avola)

Sicily, Italy

This medium bodied Italian red wine is made with the Nero D'avola grape and has nice tannins, spice, and dark fruits teasing your palate. Gulfi is one of the boutique Italian producers that overdeliver in all regards, constantly winning the Italian "Tre Bicchieri" award of best wines of Italy, every year. No literally....they win this award like, every year. Delicate earth, and spicy graphite notes round out this amazing red wine of the ages.

Cherry | Earthy | Plum

2017 Oak Farm

Tievole Cabernet Paso Robles, California

For the price, this inky, bold Cabernet really packs a punch. Think of deep blackcurrant and cassis fruits with a soft brush-stroke of baking spices. Hearty, perfect for grilling or after dinner gossip, This is a red that is framed with oak structure, but allows you to enjoy the deep, dark fruit flavors moreso than sweet vanilla oak and wooded notes.
